

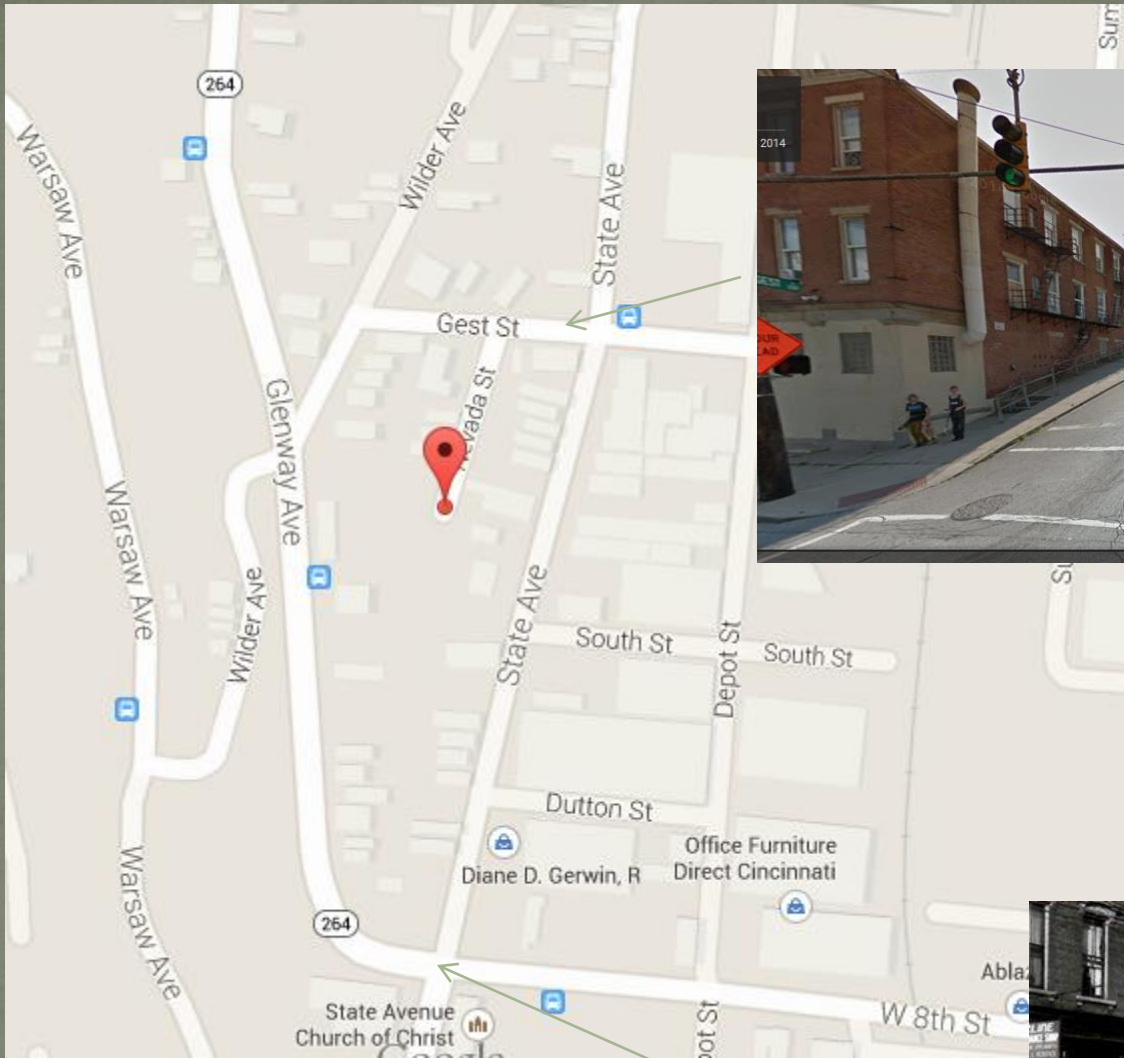

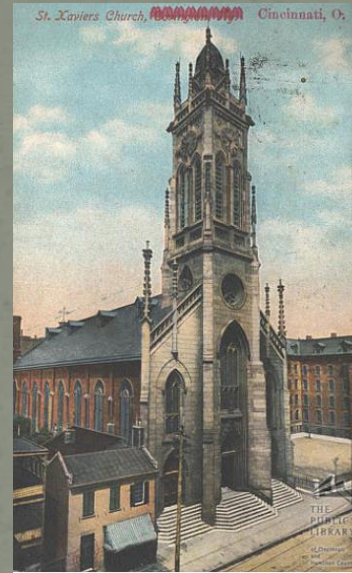
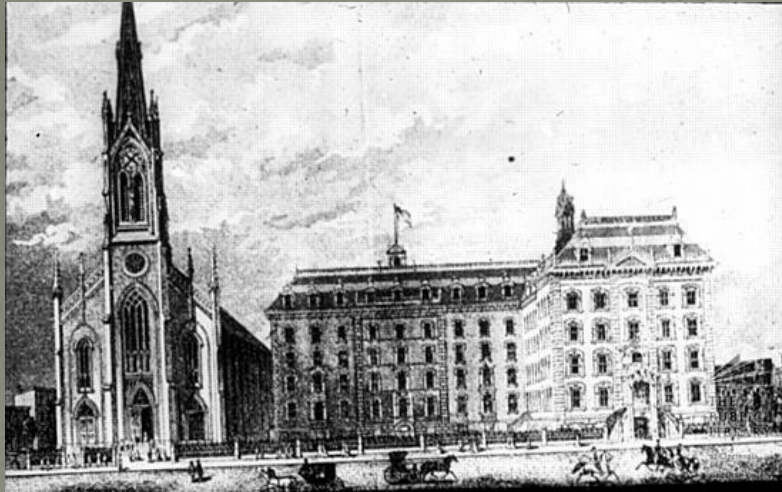

- St Xavier Church where Joseph Wright and Katherine Bruen were married in 1866



- St Peters in Chains, where Jos Wright and Margo O'Flaherty were married in 1900

## 1900 Census: East 5<sup>th</sup> St

- Katherine Wright (52) lives on East 5<sup>th</sup> Street. b 1847 and immigrated in 1854. (note her husband Joseph Wright had already passed in 1892)
- Mamie (30) is seamstress
- Emma (23) is Sales
- Joseph (21) is day laborer

# 1910 Census: all at 825 Barr St

- Patrick O'Flaherty (note, his spouse Margaret Gavin O'Flaherty had passed away the year before) ---- book-keeper
- daughter Bessie (our beloved Aunt Bess)
- daughter Katie
- daughter Margo (Margaret)



- Margo's husband Joseph Wright --- age 31, trimmer at carriage company
- 5 kids of Margo/Jos: Margaret 5, Genevieve 6, Joseph 4, Paul 1.5, Robert 7 mos.
- 3 Boarders: Mary and George Hagen, and Eliza Shirley

# Nevada > Bowman > West 8<sup>th</sup> > Crestline > Mt Hope > Glenway

- w 15<sup>th</sup>– Samuel Gray is pressman and Clarence is Sunday paper boy in 1910 (in 1904 was pressman at Byrd printing 10 Guyton in Atlanta, and printer in 1906 in Atlanta)
- 825 Barr St (Genevieve as little girl)
- 12 Nevada. Clarence streetcar conductor 1921, by 1924 he is a pressman
- 1317 Bowman. 1926 pressman. a two family with Anna Gray, Aunt Mae and Aunt Kate in the upstairs flat
- 2821 West 8<sup>th</sup> (8<sup>th</sup> and Chateau), Printer in 1933 – 1935
- 404 Crestline in 1936
- 765 Mt Hope in 1940
- 2346 Glenway in 1942, Bernard is clerk, Clarence is pressman, Dink is press reader.
- Clarence dies in 1949
- Anna Gray on West 8<sup>th</sup> was listed as Sales Helper at Rookwood Pottery

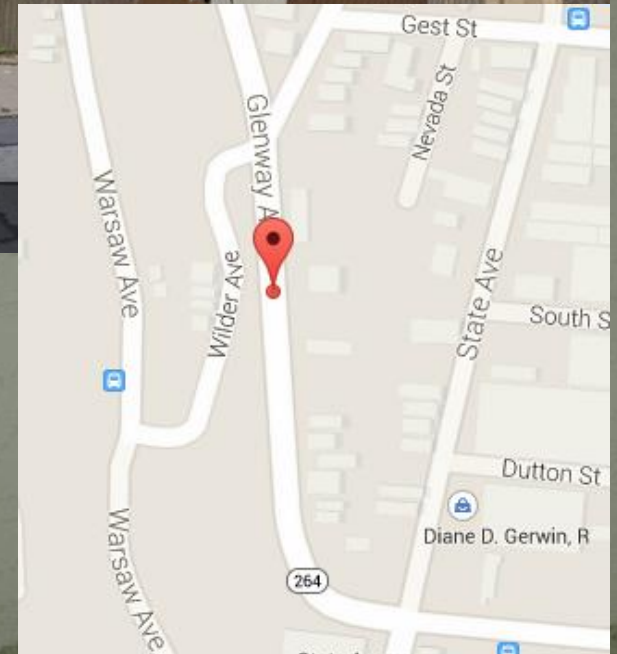
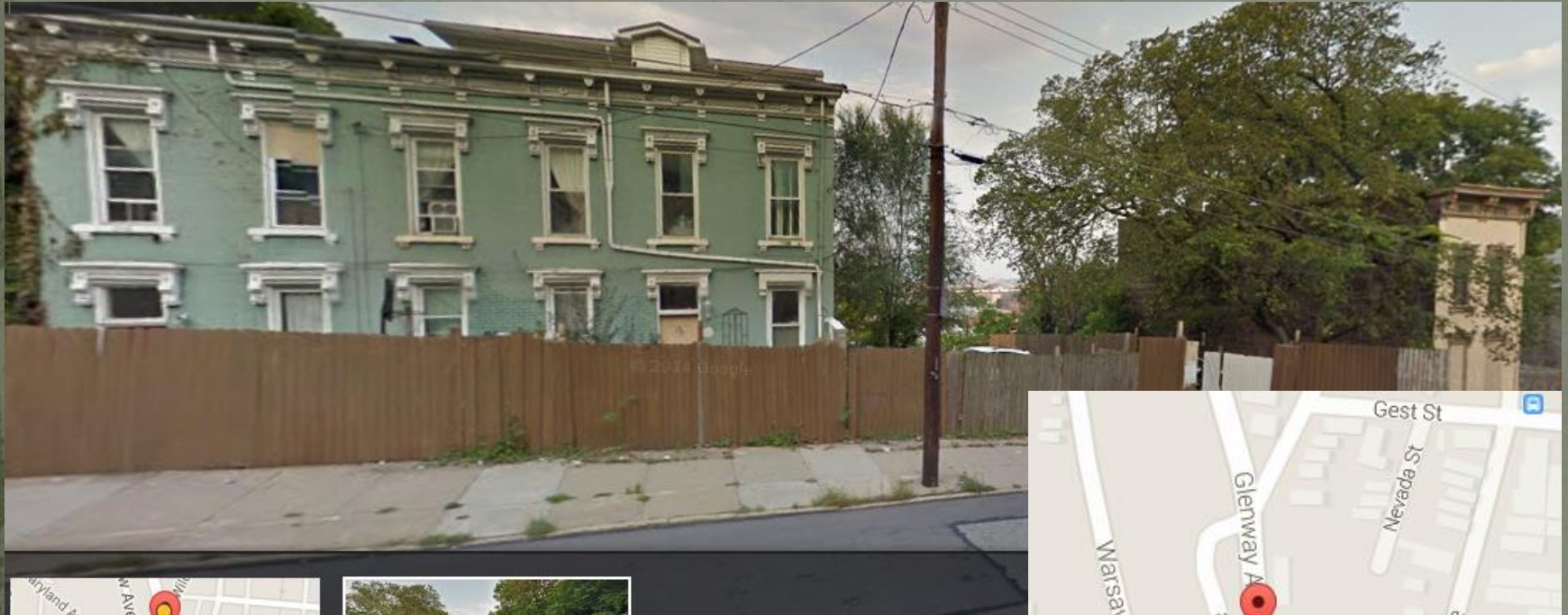

- Anna Gray – organist, taught piano
- Clarence – played violin
- Bernie and Dink born on Nevada St
- John James died at 17 days
- 1317 Bowman: full bath, gas to electric
- Baths in tin tub in kitchen. TAG soap from P&G
- Don first baby born in hospital (1928)
- Moved to 2821 W 8<sup>th</sup>
- A Model T!

- Moved to 404 Crestline after mom was born. Walking to school

- Oxford farm again when Bob was born in 1934 (102 to 109 degrees for a week)
- Using wagons for taking babies for a walk
- Uncle Tom born in 1936. Birdies sleeping, Dad??
- Crazy land lady at Crestline. "It looks so good, I'm going to raise the rent!"
- Moved to 765 Mt Hope (Sovereign, Incline)

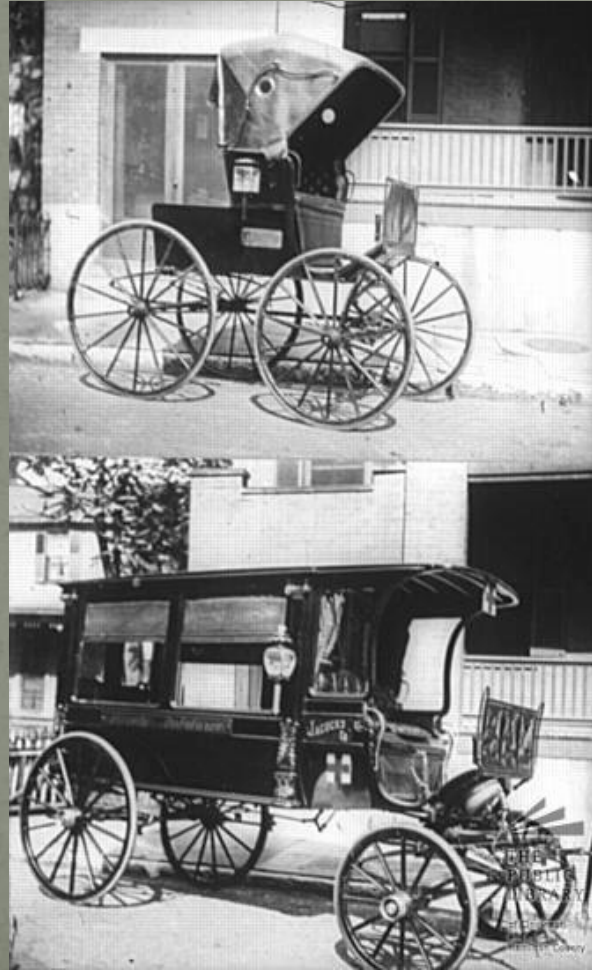
